

SuccessWare 6.0.1 Release Notes

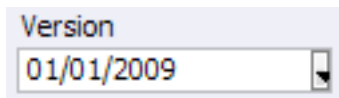
Systems No Longer Supported

- Systems prior to Windows XP Service Pack 2 are no longer supported (which includes Windows 2000).
- Mac OS X 10.3 "Panther" is no longer supported.
- Mac OS X 10.4 "Tiger" prior to version 10.4.11 is no longer supported.

Known Issues

The following issues will be resolved in a future release.

- Not compatible with Mac OS X 10.6 "Snow Leopard."
- External reminder window does not appear on Mac OS X 10.4 "Tiger."
- Appointment searching is disabled. Due to time constraints, this functionality could not be included in the first release of version 6.0. It is planned for the 6.0.1 release.
- Pop up menus do not appear properly on Windows 7. Their right sides are cut off and they look like this:



Enhancements

- Added the ability to export appointment schedules.

Just choose an item from the Export pop up menu on the scheduler window.

- Added contextual menus to appointments displayed in the scheduler window.

Right-click (or control-click on Macintosh) on an appointment to display the contextual menu. Allows you to open the appointment, display it in the Quick View window, add it to favorite appointments, and specify if the appointment has been confirmed.

- Added start and end times to the tool tips displayed when the mouse cursor

hovers over an appointment in the Month and Resources by Week views.

Fixed Issues

- On some computers, adding more than one auto email to a session or appointment caused the server application to freeze. This issue has been fixed.
- Creating a favorite appointment while displaying a Resources by Day or Resources by Week view produced an empty favorite appointment. This issue has been fixed.
- On some systems, an extraneous error –35 occurred when creating a backup log file. This issue has been fixed.
- An “hmCal error –24” appeared when setting a schedule time range to be displayed which ended at midnite. This issue has been fixed.
- In the scheduler’s Resources by Day and Resources by Week views, dragging to create an appointment under a resource added all of the resources of the same type that were selected in the Schedules list. Now, only the one resource is added along with resources of different types that are selected in the Schedules list. To get the old behavior, hold down the Alt key on Windows or the Option key on Macintosh while dragging to create the appointment.
- When creating a new appointment from a favorite appointment which was created using a pre-6.0 appointment, extraneous client information was displayed in the new appointment’s tool tips (which appear when hovering the mouse cursor over the appointment). This issue has been fixed.
- Some systems were not recognizing when an appointment was double-clicked. This issue has been fixed.
- Sunrise and sunset times displayed on the scheduler were not taking the time zone into account on Vista and Windows 7 systems. This issue has been fixed.
