

SuccessWare 7.0.2 Release Notes

Released: February 15, 2015

Systems No Longer Supported

- Systems prior to Windows 7 Service Pack 1 are no longer supported.
- Mac OS X systems prior to version 10.7.5 are no longer supported.

Known Issues

- Switching between Success Tracking, Success Pricing, and Success Planning crashes SuccessWare on some Mac OS X systems. This issue is planned to be fixed in the next release. The recommended workaround is to quit SuccessWare and relaunch while holding down the shift key until a window opens asking which SuccessWare application to open.

Enhancements

- Sped the display of appointments on the scheduler in certain circumstances.

Resolved Issues

- Fixed an erroneous Google 410 error that occurred during syncing.
- Fixed a token refresh issue with Google Contact syncing.
- Fixed an error that occurred when adding recurring expenses.
- Fixed an issue that could cause resources to be dropped from appointments when an appointment is detached from a set of recurring appointments.
- Syncing no longer stops because a sync has not occurred in the past 30 days. Now issues a warning and syncs Google updates that are less than 30 days in the past. This is necessary because of a Google limitation, but will not effect

users who sync regularly.

- Fixed an error that occurred in when appointments were detached from a set of recurring appointments.
